## **STUDENT BURSARY INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Introduction**

Eagle Ridge Hospital Auxiliary was formed in 1976 and is a volunteer service provider and fundraising organization supporting Eagle Ridge Hospital.

The Auxiliary will award two Bursaries of \$2,500 each to two graduating Tri-Cities Students planning to pursue their post-secondary school education in the field of health care. Funds are awarded at the discretion of the Auxiliary's Bursary Committee. Bursary monies will be paid directly to the post-secondary institute the winner will be attending.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants must be a Tri-Cities (Coquitlam, Port Coquitlam, or Port Moody) resident for a period of not less than two years and be planning a post-secondary education in the field of healthcare.

Successful candidates must provide proof of registration from their chosen post-secondary institute by September 15<sup>th</sup> of this year. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the award. Candidates will also be required to provide their Social Insurance Number to the Auxiliary for Income Tax purposes.

# **Documentation Required**

# <u>Failure to provide all the following documentation will result in</u> disqualification.

- 1. Proof of two years Residency in the Tri-City area.

  Proof of residency examples: student cards for 2023 and 2024, if they show home address; transcripts if they show home address; bank statements; income tax returns; utility bills in parent's names.
- 2. Copy of Academic records for Grades 11 and 12.

- 3. Two Letters of Reference from:
  - i. School Teacher or Academic Advisor
  - ii. Employer, Volunteer Leader or Organization Leader, coach, or religious leader,
- 4. Personal Letter detailing, but not limited to, the need (financial) for the Bursary, any pertinent family information you care to share, the career area chosen, the reason for pursuing this career choice, details of any volunteer service and/or employment you are or have been involved in, any clubs/organizations you belong to. The letter should be signed and dated. We want you to tell us why you think you should get a bursary. The more information and details you give us the better we can assess your application.

The Bursary Committee may request a personal interview.

## Closing Date MARCH 31<sup>ST</sup>. 2024

The winners will be advised by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. They will be requested to attend an Auxiliary Meeting in June to make a presentation. They will also be asked to sign a waiver to allow publication of their name on Social Media and/or local newsprint.
