

CRITERIA AND DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR ERH BURSARY APPLICANTS.

Introduction

The Eagle Ridge Hospital Auxiliary is pleased to offer an education bursary of \$2500. The successful applicant for this bursary will be a current health care sector employee and mature student with aspirations to upskill their education to a new role or re-enter the workforce and could use this funding for expenses related to regulatory college required course work or unpaid supervised practice experience required for re-licensure. The successful applicant can use this funding for education program fees, or other expenses incurred while participating in a full-time education program.

Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum two years continuous full time, part time or volunteer employment with Eagle Ridge Hospital or the Manor.
- For applicants re-entering the workforce, a minimum of two years continuous full-time or part-time employment with a BC Health Authority and are planning to work at ERH or the Manor
- Registered in a health-related post-secondary education program or re-entry program on a full-time status.

Documentation Required

- Personal Letter detailing, but not limited to, the need (financial) for the Bursary, the career area chosen and the reason for pursuing this career. Any other pertinent information they care to provide.
- Confirmation that government or union administered bursaries are not available.
- Proof of enrollment or regulatory college letter outlining license requirement for re-entry applicants.
- Reference from current or previous employer which should also confirm length of employment
